

Tools List for Kaska Firor Casses

Note: Some tools will be available for use during each class. For the intermediate (and especially the advanced) classes, it is highly recommended that students work with their own, familiar, tools.

Wire Wrapping Classes

General tools:

Flat nose pliers
Chain (needle) nose pliers,
Flush wire cutters,
Fine tip permanent marker
Scissors
Ruler
Masking tape (drafting or painter's tape is best)
Short wood dowels of different diameters (instructor will supply some)
Soft cloth or jeweler's polishing cloth

More advanced students will also need:

Pin vise (for twisting wire)
Round nose pliers

Optional tools:

Bent nose pliers
Small files
Ring mandrel
Raw hide or plastic jeweler's hamper
Cordless drill (lower power)

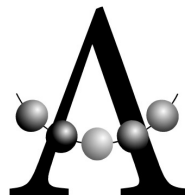
Chain Making Classes

General tools:

2 pairs of bend nose pliers (recommended)
Or, one pair of bend nose and one pair of chain nose pliers
Jump ring opener
Ruler
Few inches of plastic coated thin electrical wire for holding jump rings in place (supplied by instructor)
Magnifying lamp (5X)

Optional tools:

Rotary tumble
